As the title says, we're going to do nothing but plein air painting. If you participated in the “Plain Air Bootcamp” this is the perfect way to practice and integrate the concepts you learned. I'll do a quick demo, and then you'll plein air paint with my guidance, and we'll repeat the cycle over and over. We'll have group feedback and a discussion about focus points after each round of painting and at the end of each day.

Biography: Bill Fletcher is a Kentucky artist gaining a national reputation for his landscapes and still life paintings. He has a great love for the land and enjoys helping others develop a positive relationship with their creativity through teaching workshops and classes. Bill received his early training in art from a series of exceptional public school teachers. During that time he acquired the foundations for drawing and conceived a lifetime love of art. As an adult, Bill studied and worked in the field of Toxicology while simultaneously pursuing his interests in drawing. He began painting in oils in 1996, studying with local artists and attending workshops.
